

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM

The File of Life is a program offered by Levittown-Fairless Hills Rescue Squad to the residents of the communities we serve. Participants in the program are provided with a compact file that is stored in a red plastic sleeve. The file is used to record medical and personal information that may be needed at the time of an emergency. Some of the information contained in the File of Life may include medical history, allergies, and medications. The red sleeve is then secured to the outside of the refrigerator with a magnet, making it readily available to our crews at the time of an emergency. In the event that you are unable to effectively communicate with the EMS crew at the time of the emergency, the File of Life can provide valuable, possibly life-saving information.
